Remember: The 2012 Impact Factor is the total number of citations in 2012 to papers published in 2010 and 2011 divided by the total number of substantive papers (reviews, original articles and proceedings papers) published in 2010 and 2011.

Other measures of journal quality

Scimago Journal Rank (SJR)

This uses a different (and larger) database than the IF and a citation window of 3 years, not 2). The journal is indexed in the physiology category of the SJR. Most recent data is for 2011. SJR for 2011 = 1.114; rank = 40/132; 2nd quartile. 2010 = 1.011; rank = 42/132; 2nd quartile

In context:

Compare with the top non-review title in the category: *Cell metabolism*
2011: 7.770 (3rd in category); 2010: 7.871 (2nd).

Usage

Full-text downloads are a reflection of **real** interest in an article, unfettered by the political issues of the impact factor. Full text downloads to articles in the journal have risen dramatically year on year and now exceed 21,000 per month.
