Other measures of journal quality

Scimago Journal Rank (SJR)

This uses a different (and larger) database than the IF and a citation window of 3 years, not 2). The journal is indexed in the gastroenterology category of the SJR. Most recent data is for 2013. SJR for 2013 = 1.71; rank = 16/132; 1^{st} quartile.

Altmetrics

All articles in Neurogastroenterology & Motility now receive an individual Altmetrics score, seen online at the end of each paper. These scores provide data about social media activity and discussions relating to individual papers from social media sources, the mainstream media, and online reference managers.
